



The International Contemporary Ensemble (ICE),

the 2005 winner of the CMA/ASCAP Award for Adventurous Programming,
announces its second

21st Century Young Composers Project Call-for-Scores.

Up to five young composers will be selected for inclusion in ICE's 2006-07 concert season in Chicago and New York City. Winners will receive all-expenses paid trips to collaborate with ICE on multiple performances and recordings of their works. Composers will work intensively with the ensemble, and will participate in public rehearsals, workshops, radio interviews and panel discussions about their work.

ICE welcomes submissions by young composers from any country who meet the following guidelines:

- Composer must be age 35 or under.
- The work must have been written in the year 2000 or after.
- The work may be for **up to ten** of any combination of the following instruments:
3 vln, 2 vla, 2 vlc, 1 cb, 2 perc, 2 pno, 2 hp, 2 fl, 2 cl, 1 ob,
1 bsn, 1 sax, 2 trpt, 1 hn, 1 trb, 1 gtr.
Work may include live or pre-recorded electronics.
- Composer must be willing to travel to the U.S. during the 2006-07 season for performances.
- Past YCP Winners are ineligible to apply a second time.

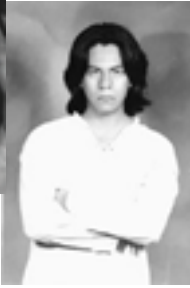

21st Century Young Composers Project Call-for-Scores

Submission procedures:

- Submit only ONE work with a full score and CD recording. Cassette tapes or DATS will not be accepted.
- Include a cover letter briefly describing your interest in collaborating with ICE; and one copy of your CV or resume with your contact information, including an e-mail address where you can be reached. In some cases, we may e-mail you to request additional materials and work samples.
- A \$10 (US) processing fee must be included with the application, payable to International Contemporary Ensemble. In the case of financial hardship, we will waive this fee.
- Submissions must be RECEIVED BY (not postmarked by) December 1, 2005. Send all materials to:
